



## CHP Hospitality Route Dressage & Show Jumping

Start: Volunteer Pavilion with Volunteer Coordinator

- Make sure cooler and snacks are packed in golf cart
- Divide lunches and place half in golf cart, leave half in pavilion
- If awards team is in pavilion, offer lunch

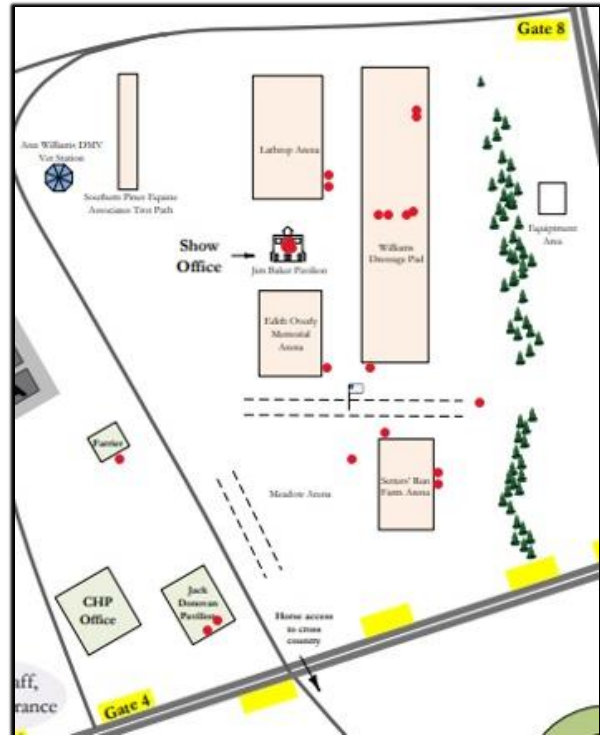
Driving Route:

1. Farrier station
2. SRF warm up (grass field) and in gate
3. SRF judge's booth (between arena and tree line)
4. EMTs (usually stationed between SRF in gate and Overly warmup)
5. Overly warm up and in gate
6. Lathrop Arena: dressage warmup
7. Dressage Pad: judges and scribes
  - a. Avoid driving on dressage pad, if possible
  - b. Drive on grass around outside and walk to judges/scribes
  - c. Be careful not to interrupt dressage test
8. Baker Show Office
  - a. Front desk, scorers, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor
  - b. Ask Sarah or Margaret (front desk) if anyone else needs lunch
  - c. Radio call to crew, if needed

End:

- Return to Volunteer Pavilion
- Pick up remaining lunches and drive to Park Office (small house)
- Place left over lunches, if any, in office refrigerator
- Don't forget to feed yourself!

**\*\*Drive route every hour or two to offer drinks and snacks or bathroom breaks, if needed.\*\***
